Tanga Cement Plc Donates 600 bags of Cement for Completion of the Home for Vulnerable Elders and Wall Fence to Tushikamane Pamoja Foundation

Tanga, 26 August 2016 – Tanga Cement Public Limited Company, has donated a total of Six hundred (600) bags of Simba cement as a donation towards completion of construction of the home for vulnerable elders to Tushikamane Pamoja Foundation (TPT). The house is at Kwembe, in Kinondoni district, Dar es Salaam. The total cost of the donated cement is Tzs7,257,000.

Speaking during the handing-over ceremony, Tanga Cement Plc's Plant Manager Eng. Benedict Lema said; "As a Company, Tanga Cement Plc has been supporting the Tanzanian community by sharing our profit with them. We normally give back to the community, 1% of our profit, while focusing in the areas of education, health, community development and environment. We also look at the humanitarian aids, especially the ones in needy like this one".

If you can remember, in 2010, here at the same venue, we donated some mattresses to Tanga Mature citizens home through Raskazone women group. This is another group, a women group that is taking care of mature citizens. Now my call to fellow men, when will we see men's group doing the same? Every day we are seeing group of women. If we can have several men's group that are doing similar activities, we will make this group of people very comfortable. Tushikamane pamoja group is about to accomplish construction of their home, definitely this home will need some furniture, it would be better if they get support for that, and that support should come from men's group. I challenge fellow men, I believe we can do this.

Tanga Cement PLC has already given back to the community, this year, 2016, a total of Tzs192million.
