Tanga Cement Company Limited Hands-over A block of two Classrooms and Toilets

Arumeru, 14 November 2012 - Tanga Cement Company Limited hands over a block of two furnished classrooms and a block of toilets to Medeye Secondary School located in Arumeru district, Arusha region. The company spent a total of Tzs60.2million in the construction and furnishing of the classrooms and a block of toilets. The company furnished the classroom with a total of 70 desks and 70 chairs.

Speaking at the handing-over ceremony, the Company's Managing Director Mr. Erik Westerberg said: "We have a policy that allows us to spend up to 1% of our pre-tax profit for the Tanzanian community and this is the money that we have been giving back to the community. We have divided our CSR focus in four main areas of Health, Education, Community development and sustainability as well as Environment".

Mr. Westerberg further said: "We are doing this to support Government's initiative of developing education in Tanzania. The Government has been asking for a support for a number of education facilities like classrooms, desks, books, dormitories and others country wide". "These are our children who need education, so they need our helping hand on this". He added: "We, Tanga Cement Company Limited have managed to support Medeye Secondary School, am sure there are

other supporters who are able to do so for other schools, so let's do it; There are other needs for many schools in Tanzania”.
